Call to Order

The Concerned Taxpayers of Duval County (CTDC) meeting convened on Monday, June 8 at 6:24 PM.

May 2009 Minutes

The April 2009, May 2009 and May 2009 Special Board meeting minutes were accepted without modification

Treasurer's Report

The treasurer's report was accepted without objection. The current balance was \$559.24. A report to the Supervisor of Elections office is due next month.

Charter Revision Commission

Conrad Markle and Joe Andrews went to the inaugural meeting of the Charter Revision Commission. The main meeting of the commission will be in City Council chambers and will allow public comment, but public comment during individual committee meetings is undetermined at this point.

CTDC Lawsuit Against the City

There has been no public hearing on the CTDC lawsuit vs the city of Jacksonville. John Winkler has not read the Waste Management lawsuit, but will do so soon.

Three Fees

City Council member Glorious Johnson will likely introduce a bill on repeal of the fees soon.

May 30th Special Board meeting

The meeting was well attended and fruitful. It resulted in a good list of priorities for the CTDC for the year.

Protests

There are no plans for protests concerning the Richard Clark's and others' trip to Paris upon their return at this time.

Meetup Group

The CTDC now has a Meetup group set up by Shane Schumerth. Rob Morrill moved that Shane be reimbursed \$45 for the expense of signing up the Meetup group. The motion was seconded and approved without objection.

Legislative Watch Committee

Joe Andrews commented on recent bad legislation proposed by City Council members. Joe Andrews made a motion to establish a Legislative Watch Committee that will monitor bills newly introduced to the City Council and post questionable bills to the website as they arise. The motion was seconded and approved without objection.
