Call to Order

The Concerned Taxpayers of Duval County meeting convened on Monday September 8th at 6:25 PM.

August 2008 Minutes

The August 2008 minutes were accepted without modification.

Treasurer's Report

The treasurer's report was accepted without objection. The current balance was \$642.31.

Mayor Peyton's three fees

There was discussion on whether to oppose Mayor Peyton's three fees now or wait until the new City Council persons take their seats on the council. Joe Andrews noted that it is likely that we did not have the votes to repeal the fees. Tony Bates noted that any effort to repeal the fees probably should have taken place earlier in the budget cycle.

Jacksonville Economic Development Commission (JEDC)

After the budget cycle is complete, a one year moratorium bill on the JEDC will likely be introduced in the City Council.
